1. Introduction

Wahnapitae is seeking proposals from qualified contractors to undertake necessary repairs and upgrades to a critical infrastructure asset of Wahnapitae First Nation Centre of Excellence

This RFP provides the guidelines and requirements for submitting proposals for this project.

2. Project Background

The Centre of Excellence, constructed in 2012, is experiencing stain siding, premature failure of its finish and calking is cracking needing to be replaced. This preventative maintenance is required to ensure the building envelope keeps moisture out. These issues have necessitated the planned repairs and upgrades outlined in this document.

3. Project Overview

Identified Problems:

1. Wall Wooden Siding:

Good Fellow Wood Siding weathered and rotting. Calking is cracked and allowing moisture to enter building possibly causing rotting in wall/damage of interior walls /flooring and trim.

2. Windows and Doors

Calking cracked and weathered

3. Front Entrance Main Beams:

 Rain and weather have compromised the clear coat Varathane finish and wood is beginning to rot.

Scope of Work:

1. Wood Siding:

 Scrap/ Sand/ Fill cracks to prepare siding for refinish with suggested stain or equivalent product. 2. EAST & WEST WALL to be excluded from refinish pricing as NEW siding product will be install over siding



- 3. Vertical Wood Siding: PT2 SW 7048 URBANE BRONZE by SHERWIN WILLIAMS
- 4. Diagonal Wood Siding: PT1 SW 7047 PORPOISE by SHERWIN WILLIAMS
- 5. Horizontal Wood Siding PT1 SW 7047 PORPOISE by SHERWIN WILLIAMS
- 6. Vertical Wood Batton and Horizontal Wood Battens: : PT2 SW 7048 URBANE BRONZE by SHERWIN WILLIAMS
- 7. Corner Batten: PT2 SW 7048 URBANE BRONZE by SHERWIN WILLIAMS
- 8. Inside Corner Batten: PT2 SW 7048 URBANE BRONZE by SHERWIN WILLIAMS
- 9. Remove all Exterior Calking and re apply new fresh calking replace with best superior recommended sealant to keep out moisture.
- 10. **Front Entrance:** Scrap/ Sand/ Fill cracks to prepare Beams for new refinished look and clear coat protectant. And cap beams with aluminium flashing.

11. Eve re-finish:

- Prep under Eve and front beams for new clearcoat protectant all around the building.
- 12. Remove Norman Recollet Health service Centre red lettering only

4. Deliverables

- New refurbished stained siding
- Main Entrance Glulam Wood Beams refurbished and Aluminium Capped
- New colour match Calking all exterior joints
- Remove Norman Recollet Health service Centre red lettering only
- Project completion documentation.
