Intent

Wahnapitae First Nation seeks to continually provide a welcoming and comfortable environment which ensures trust and respect for all members, visitors, staff, committee members and volunteers. Wahnapitae First Nation strives to provide a safe environment. In order to maintain our longstanding reputation in the community, we have established this Code of Conduct to specify our expectations.

- Committee Member should thoroughly read their Committee Terms of Reference before attending Committee meetings so that time is used optimally.
- 2. Committee Member should focus their discussions on the Agenda item being addressed to facilitate decision-making. Issues will be dealt with one at a time.
- 3. Committee Member should adhere to the Agenda except in crisis situations.
- 4. Committee Member will exercise self-control in presenting personal points of view and should show respect for viewpoints differing from their own.
- 5. Committee Member should adhere to facts relevant to the issue under discussion during Committee meetings. Questionable, unsubstantiated comments should be kept out of Committee discussions.
- 6. Committee Member will show respect for each other's opinions and viewpoints.
- 7. Committee Member will not talk negative about WFN, WFN staff members, band members, community members or anyone in particular.
- 8. Committee Member should remember their primary concern is for their community and for the community membership they serve.
- The Chair does not vote on issues and will only vote to break a tie vote. Decisions of the MAJORITY of Committee Members must be represented.
- 10. Committee Member will be aware and knowledgeable of Band policies and procedures and will support in the Band Administration in implementing all band policies, administration, finance and governing.
