Wahnapitae First Nation Funding Criteria and Application Process Procedures for Gezhtoojig Employment and Training Dollars

To receive training dollar funding, the applicant must be:

- A registered status member of Wahnapitae First Nation or;
- A non-status member living on the First Nation for three months prior to them making application and;
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Follow all guidelines and criteria set forth by Gezhtoojig Employment and Training

Application Process Procedure of Gezhtoojig Employment and Training Fund & Wahnapitae First Nation

- Application and recommendation from Gezhtoojig Employment and Training will be submitted to Wahnapitae First Nation for final approval.
- If the amount applied for is under \$10,000.00 dollars the Executive Director and the Education Director will assess the application and notify Gezhtoojig of final decision whether the application is denied or approved in writing with reason within 5 Business Days of receiving the application.
- If the amount applied for is over \$10,000.00 the Executive Director and the Education Director will review and with their recommendation, will submit the final application to Chief and Council for final approval.
- Chief and Council will then advise Executive Director and Education Director of the final decision of the application, then the Executive Director and the Education Director will notify our Representative at Gezhtoojig Employment and Training of the final decision whether it is approved or denied.
- If the application is denied the applicant will follow the appeal process set out by Gezhtoojig Employment and Training.

Amendment: This Policy can be amended from time to time by the Chief and Council.
