**Purpose/Intent:**

The Medical Transportation program defines the components and the nature of the services rendered as per the Wahnapiatae First Nation Medical Transportation policy p. 2 and 3. It describes how services are reflective of the needs of our clients.

**Policy Statement:**

Services Provided:

- Norman Recollet Health Centre will provide a Medical Driver if one is available for individuals who do not own a vehicle or are unable to drive themselves for mechanical, legal, or medical reasons and unable to find a ride or hire a driver.
- Norman Recollet Health Centre will provide medical transportation services to attend medical appointments including:
  - Physician
  - Hospital
  - Diagnostic/X-RAY
  - Optometrist
  - Alcohol/Drug Treatment/Detox
  - Specialist
  - Dentist
  - Traditional Healer (with medical referral)
  - Specialist referred outside City of Greater Sudbury (Pick-up/drop-off at bus depot, City of Greater Sudbury)

**Procedures:**

- Persons served are picked up from their home and taken to a medical appointment as directed. The driver may assist the patient to attend their appointment and return them home once the appointment is complete.
