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Eligibility Criteria to work with Wahnapiatae First Nation

1. Compliance with Tender Submission Guidelines:

- Bidders must submit tenders as per the guidelines, including the use of the provided Tender Form and adherence to the submission deadline.

2. Financial and Pricing Requirements:

- Tenders must include an all-inclusive price in Canadian currency.
- Prices should exclude the Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) but include all other taxes, levies, and duties.

3. Insurance and Bonding:

- Subcontractors are required to have a Wrap Up General Insurance liability policy with a minimum coverage of \$5,000,000 and an All Risks Property Insurance policy.
- Proof of ability to acquire bonding is mandatory, even if bonding is not required for the project.

4. Building Code Compliance:

- All construction must comply with the National Building Code of Canada and any applicable local building codes.
- The contractor is responsible for ensuring compliance and handling all necessary inspections and documentation.

5. Project Management and Coordination Skills:

- The successful proponent must demonstrate the ability to manage and coordinate the project effectively, including all stages from planning to construction and closeout.

6. Understanding of Project Scope and Requirements:

- Bidders must show a clear understanding of the project's scope as per the specified requirements and within the budget.

7. Submission of Required Documentation:

- This includes completed submission forms, a proposed construction schedule, a completed CCDC11 form, reference letters, and a comprehensive letter of understanding and methodology.

8. Quality of Past Work and References:

- Bidders must provide three reference letters from clients or consultants, each for a different project, demonstrating their capability and experience in similar projects.

9. Adherence to Safety Standards:

- Compliance with the Provincial Occupational Health and Safety Act and regulations, along with providing necessary safety measures and insurance, is crucial.

10. Resource Availability:

- Bidders must have the necessary manpower, materials, and equipment, and be able to include costs for overtime and shift premiums to meet the project schedule.
